# ABOUT THE FOUNDATION

Prangan Foundation is a non-governmental organization, based out of Dombivli, which currently has 2 successful projects in the running. Prangan Foundation was registered on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2018, Project Chanchalman places its focus on imparting the knowledge of English to the children belonging to the lower socio-economic background of the society. This project was started on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2018. It has **100\*\* EDUCATORS** and **74\*\* CHILDREN**. Prangan's library places its focus on bringing back the long-lost habit of reading. It is a library that has its doors open for every person willing to read. The library was started on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020.

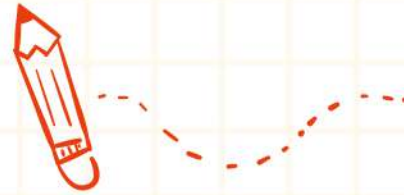

There are so many loopholes to be filled when it comes to education in India. A lot of other issues arises because of people not being educated properly. A total of only 60% of the Indian population who are 15 years and older are educated. Children in India, lack resources. Even if there are good school, colleges and universities, majority of them cannot afford to be admitted in them due to the amount of money, they are asked to pay. In a country like ours, where poverty is one of the leading issues, quality education, which can be afforded by everyone, is the only way out to lead an individual out of poverty.

The shocking state of students in and around us and the quality of their lives, inspired us to start an NGO which would particularly take interest in educating the children who belong to a lower socio-economic background and help them to give colour to their own lives. We registered ourselves as an NGO on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2018 and inaugurated our first centre on the auspicious day 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2018. Prangan Foundation is a roof to two successful projects, Project Chanchalman and Prangan's Library. Project Chanchalman runs 2 centres in Dombivli West, the Lily and the Lavender. **The student count rose to 74 and educator count crosses 80+.** Prangan's Library is a novel initiative to help youngsters re inculcate the habit of reading. It is a digital two way interface that makes possible requests and donation to the library.



# HOW WE WORK



The sessions at Project Chanchalman focus solely on the holistic development of the children enrolled, we try to accomplish this by adopting inclusive learning. Saturdays and Sundays, at both the centres have a more or less similar schedule but a bunch of different ideas every session. No one session is same to that of others. The 2.5 hours on each day of the weekend start with kids assembling in their classes, followed by their beloved educators. The sessions are generally a mix of classroom-textbook activities and outdoor activities, the centre managers and the team of enthusiastic educators do a wonderful job in striking the right balance between the two. After a short break, the students reassemble in the classroom and proceed with the activities that are specifically designed according to their requirements. The sessions conclude with a prayer and a summary of the class conducted is taken after.

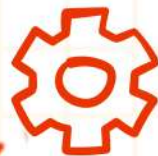

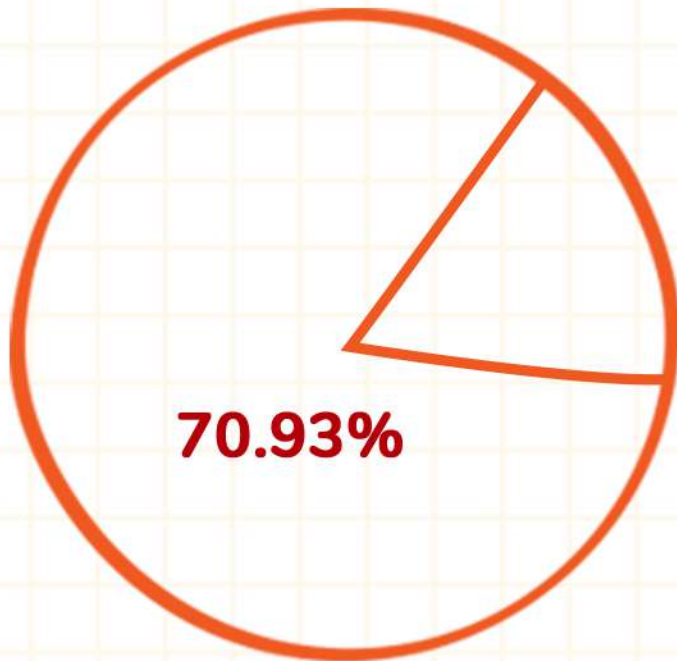

# STATISTICS

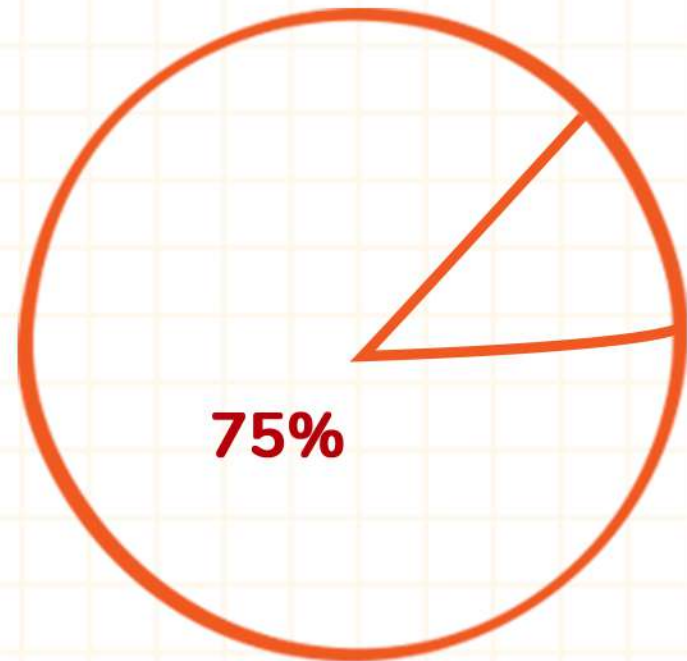
As per the statistics that were derived, it was found out that 27.59% educators are the ones who have stayed with us since the inception, 72.41% of educators are new joiners. 16 out of 58 educators are old educators. i.e. almost 1 of every 4 educators is an old educator. The average attendance of both the centers combined is 55.91%. The average attendance of Lily is 47.30% and that of Lavender is 62.63%. Coming to talk about student's attendance, Lavender has an average attendance of 70.93% and Lily has an average Attendance of 75%. The total average attendance is 72.965%



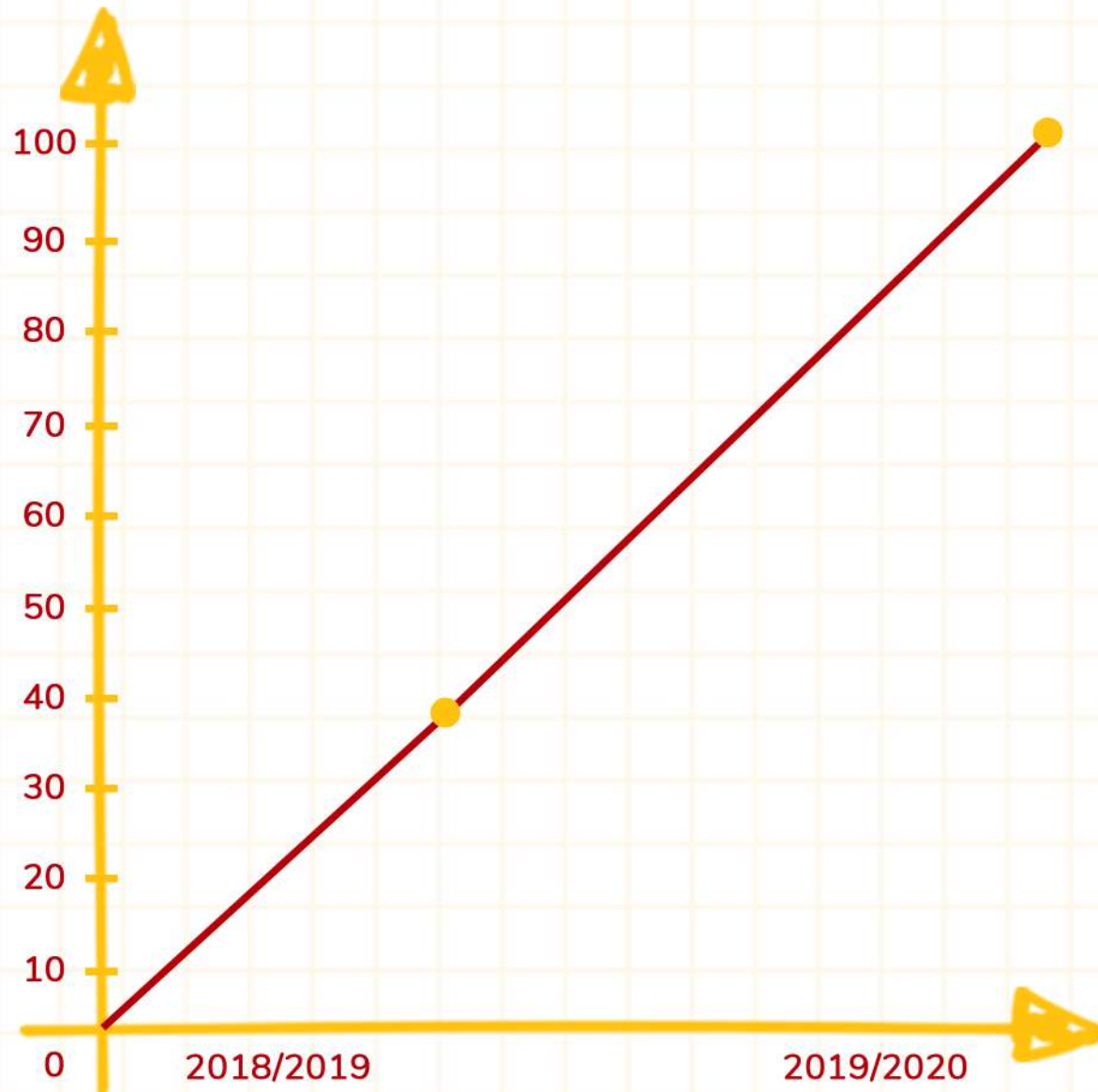
Average students attendance (**Lavender**)

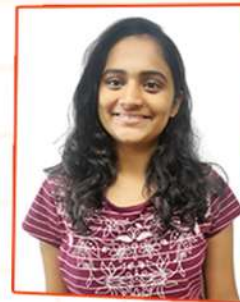

## UNIQUE IDEA USED IN THE FIELD

The unique idea that is incorporated in our teaching learning system is that, we conduct our sessions on weekends for two and a half hours, both the days. The motto behind conducting these sessions is to inspire children, impart knowledge and to impact the society. The educator-pupil ration in our **NGO is 1:4**, which means we have **1 educator for 4 pupils**. The books that we use for the students are from **Cambridge Publications**. We place our main focus on developing the LSRW skills, which means, listening, speaking, reading and writing.

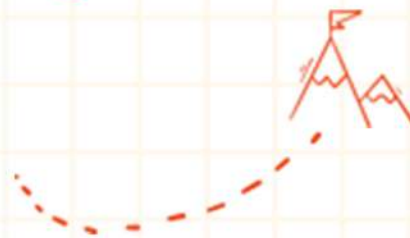




# KOTHALIGADH CHARITY TREK
